## HARVEST SERVICE

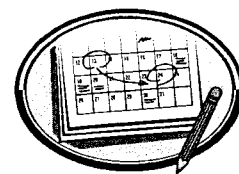

## COATS

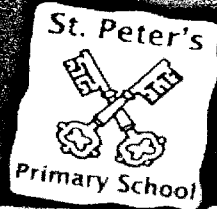
