5	 Revised Budget Budget meeting with Schools Finance Officer took place on 21 October Revised projection reviewed by Resources committee in their meeting last week Projection is we will be better off at the end of the year by £28k primarily due to receiving falling roles funding, wraparound care grant and continued prudent spending. This means we should end the year with a £12.5k surplus however it doesn't really change our situation going forward in the future Resources committee propose revised budget for ratification Decision – governors agreed to approve revised budget 	CT to submit revised budget to LA
