**Y5 and Y6 VISIT TO ABOLITION AFLOAT AND NEW ROOMS, BRISTOL
THURSDAY 23 MARCH 2023**

As part of our topic 'Bristol and the Slave Trade', we have organised a trip to visit some locations in Bristol to support the children's understanding. The children will take part in a cruise around the floating harbour called 'Abolition Afloat' and then visit John Wesley's New Room, the oldest Methodist building in the world.

The timetable for the day is as follows:

- Coach leaving St Peter's at 9:15 am.
- Arrive in Bristol (Castle Park) at approximately 9:45 am
- First session Abolition Afloat (Y6)/New Room (Y5) 10:00am
- Lunch in Castle Park at 12:30pm
- Second session Abolition Afloat (Y5)/New Room (Y6) at 1pm
- Leave Bristol (Castle Park) at 3:00pm
- Return to St Peter's at approximately 3:30 pm

The children will need to:

- Wear school uniform
- Bring a packed lunch (including a plastic bottle of water and snacks for both morning and afternoon) **in a small back pack.**

Your child will be in a small group accompanied by a member of staff or parent helper.

The school kitchen is able to offer a packed lunch (chosen through parentpay). These must be booked in advance of the school trip.

The costs for the coach travel and entrance to the attraction have been substantially subsidised thanks to support from St Peter's Church & Bristol & South Glos Methodist Circuit. To enable the visit to take place a voluntary contribution of £4.00 is required to cover the remaining costs. However, the trip can only take place if there are sufficient voluntary contributions; if not then the trip may not proceed. If any parents of a pupil are in receipt of benefit related free school meals, please contact the school office in confidence to discuss financial support.
