Plants need water, sunlight and food to grow.

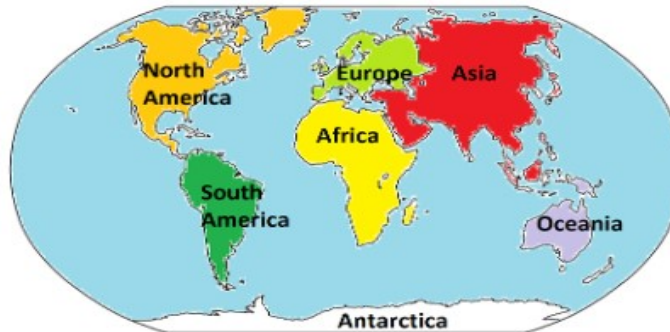

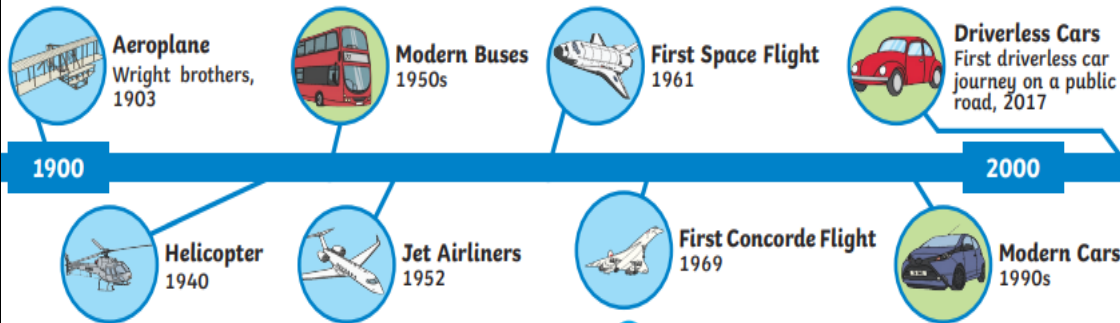
