World War 2 Timeline... The Phoney War Sept 1939 - April 1940 Germany invades Poland. Britain and Sen France declare war on Germany - Start of 1939 World War 2 Blitzkrieg April 1940 - June 1940 Dunkirk evacuated (UK troops rescued from beaches) and France surrenders to Germany. Germany uses 'blitzkrieg' to take over much of Western Europe Britain and Empire Alone July 1940 - June 1941 Germany launches air attacks on Britain July Germany, Italy and Japan signed the 1940 Tripartite Pack creating an alliance The Tide Turns 1941 - 1943 Hitler invades Russia in Operation June 1941 Barbarossa but was defeated Japanese attack US Navy Pearl harbour Dec 7 Dec 8 USA enters war, with the allies 1941 Americans defeat Japanese B. of Midway. 1942 Russians defeat Nazis B. of Stalingrad British won B. of El-Alamein (Egypt) Victory 1943 - 1945 D-Day and the Normandy Invasion June 6 Allied forces invade France and push back 1944 the Germans, incl hombing German cities Russians advanced to Eastern Europe, April Berlin. Adolf Hitler commits suicide 1945 Germany surrenders and victory in Europe Mau 7 is declared - VE DAY 1945 Atomic bombs dropped on Hiroshima and August Nagasaki, Japan by the US killing 945 226,000 people Japan surrenders signalling end of WW2 Sept 2 1945 - VJ DAY
