YEAR 1 & 2 VISIT TO SS GREAT BRITAIN FRIDAY 13 OCTOBER 2023

As part of our KS1 topic 'Brunel', we have arranged a visit to the SS Great Britain, Bristol on Friday 13th October 2023.

The children will take part in a workshop called "Brunel The Engineer" and have a tour of the ship.

The timetable for the day is as follows:

- Coach leaving St Peter's at 9.15am
- Arrive at SS Great Britain at 10:00am
- Leave SS Great Britain at 2:00pm
- Return to St Peter's at approximately 2.45pm

The children will need to:

- Wear school uniform
- Bring a packed lunch (including a plastic bottle of water and snacks for both morning and afternoon) in a small back pack.

Your child will be in a small group accompanied by a member of staff or parent helper.

To enable the visit to take place a voluntary contribution of £11.50 per child is required to cover the cost of the trip. The cost of the coach transport (approx. £7.80 per child) has been subsidised generously by a donation from the Friends of St Peter's and our school trip fund allowing us to subsidise the cost of the trip to you. If any parents of a pupil are in receipt of benefit related free school meals or have difficulty making the payment, please contact the school office in confidence to discuss financial support.
