YEAR 5 & 6 VISIT TO MSHED, BRISTOL FRIDAY 13 OCTOBER 2023

As part of our topic 'World War II', we have arranged a visit to the MShed, Bristol on Friday 13th October 2023.

The children will take part in a workshop called "Bristol at war, the home front" and have a tour of the museum.

The timetable for the day is as follows:

- Coach leaving St Peter's at 9.30am
- Arrive at MShed, Bristol at 10:00am
- Leave MShed, Bristol at 2:30pm
- Return to St Peter's at approximately 3.00pm

The children will need to:

- We encourage children and adults to come dressed in clothes that match the styles worn in the 1940s:
- Boys/men: flat cap, shorts or trousers, braces, plain shirt, a wool jumper or waistcoat.
- Girls: a simple dress or a blouse and skirt.
- Women: a dress or a skirt and blouse with a cardigan and hat.
- Bring a packed lunch (including a plastic bottle) in a small back pack. (If you would like a school packed lunch please let the office know and make this selection on Arbor meals)

Your child will be in a small group accompanied by a member of staff or parent helper.

To enable the visit to take place a voluntary contribution of £10.00 per child is require. The cost of the coach transport & visit (approx. £4.50 per child) has been subsidised generously by a donation from our school trip fund allowing us to subsidise the cost of the trip to you. If any parents of a pupil are in receipt of benefit related free school meals or have difficulty making the payment, please contact the school office in confidence to discuss financial support.

Please log into the Arbor parent portal or App to give your consent for your child to attend and to make payment for this trip by <u>FRIDAY 6TH OCTOBER</u>.
