PARENTS EVENINGS

PARENTAL SURVEY

Thank you to those who completed the parental survey that was sent out via email link last month. The response from that was positive. One aspect that was highlighted where we could improve was in regard to what the pupils are learning. Therefore, there has been a greater amount of information placed on the website to share overviews and topics with parents. Please do look at the class pages on the website for more information and download these. One other aspect is where some parents didn't feel that concerns were dealt with either swiftly or well. Each concern that comes to school is dealt with within a very short timeframe. Unfortunately, there are some things which are out of our control but we endeavour to work with parents to solve any issues. If you feel that you have not been heard then please follow this up with either myself or Mr Baykaa-Murray. If you do have any concerns that are still outstanding please raise them with your class teachers first. A good time to do this would be at the upcoming parents evening. The survey was the same one that Ofsted will send out when we get our next inspection so you know what to expect.

SCHOOL DINNERS

Please can parents remember that all school dinners should be paid for in advance of booking a school meal. We understand last minute bookings are made but these should be paid for the same day please. Bookings should be made and paid for using the Arbor App/Parent Portal. If your child is always the same choice (e.g always a packed lunch or always fish fingers on a Friday) then this can be selected on the app to save you logging in each week. Bookings can be made right up to Christmas and the menu for term 3 & 4 is now on the website to view.

BREAKFAST/AFTER SCHOOL CLUB BOOKINGS

Thank you to all parents/carers for getting on board with our new booking system for breakfast and after school club sessions on Arbor which is working well. Please can we ask you to note the following –

- Please book sessions as far in advance as possible. We understand that you may need last minute sessions
 on occasions but if you can book in advance for the week at least where possible this would be very helpful
- If you pay by childcare vouchers, please send these payments over well in advance of needing to use them, some providers take a few days to send the funds over to us so this may delay you being able to book
- If you need to cancel or amend a session, please email the office and we can do this for you. Currently there
 isn't a way for parents to do this themselves on Arbor but we have passed a request onto them to add this
 feature as feedback
- If you book your child in for a same day after school club session, can you please let the office know as we do not currently get notifications of sessions being booked and we print the list of bookings in the morning to plan for the session (this has also been passed on as feedback to Arbor to add as a feature)




E-SAFETY FOR PARENTS
