# CAROLS AT THE MALL, CRIBBS CAUSEWAY – THURSDAY 14<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER

Year 5 will be performing with the Bridge Family of School's at the Mall, Cribbs Causeway on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December.

1. Meeting Point: Please bring your child to the fire exit doors next to '**Rituals**' on the ground floor by **4:15pm**. The children will then be ushered into the corridor in their school groups where they will be escorted into their singing positions.

2. Performance Location: The children will be performing in the centre of the Mall. They will be positioned on the stairs and on a stage covering the fountain. The carols will begin at 4:30pm and finish by 5:00pm.

3. Collection of children: As the Mall will most probably be quite busy at the end of the performance, they have requested each school meet in a specific location for collection.

#### PARKING ON SCHOOL GROUNDS



There are still parents insisting on parking in the school to drop off their children.

The only place this is permissible is the 'drop off zone' where the parents can quickly stop, say good bye, allow their children to exit the car and then drive off to allow other parents to do the same.

This should take no longer than a few seconds. Some parents have been seen waiting as their child walks up the path, brushing their child's hair and conversing with other parents! It is inconsiderate and dangerous as lengthy queues form behind waiting to get in to the school and blocking Bank Road. Furthermore, at the end of the day, there is a small minority of parents who continually park in the car park to collect their children. We do not allow this at all. Parents must park their cars



on the street and walk into the school unless you have a disabled parking badge or legitimate reason and have an agreement in advance from either Mr BM, Mr Smith or the office. <u>From January 2024, we will be closing</u> <u>the gates to stop this</u>. Blue Badge Holders are still permitted to park on the grounds however we would ask that you arrive no later 15:05. These measures will be in place for the safety and wellbeing of our children at St Peter's and fairness to all parents. Please respect this and park accordingly. Please also ensure anyone else collecting your children on your behalf are aware of this.

#### Walking in to School

A number of parents are also walking with their children through the car parks. This is very dangerous. Please use the footpaths provided (dotted green arrows), do not cut through the car park (red crosses) and set a good example for our children.
