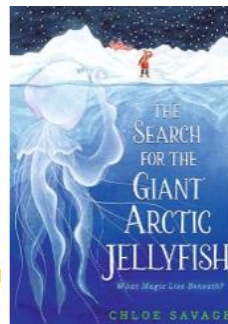
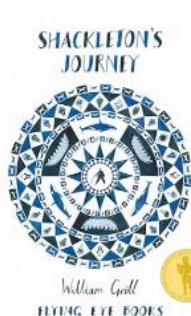
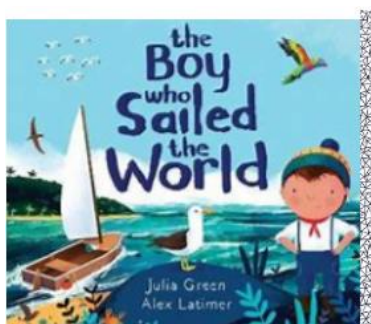
**Year: 2023 – 2024**

**KS1**

**Theme: 'I am an adventurer'**

#### English

- We will look at a variety of text types: poetry, fiction and non-fiction that fit with our topic.
- We will continue to write short sentences, building up to writing a longer series of linked sentences and narratives, descriptions, and poems.
- We will look at extending our sentences using conjunctions.
- We will make our writing more interesting with different types of punctuation such as exclamation marks and question marks.
- We will discuss, our books, orally rehearse parts of the text and retrieve answers.



#### Mathematics

Year 1: We will start by looking at addition and subtraction within 20. We will focus on

- Adding by counting in and making 10
- Subtraction both crossing and not crossing 10

We will then move on to place value within 50 :

- Counting and recognising numbers to 50
- Comparing numbers to 50
- Counting in 2s and 5s

Year 2: We will start by looking at multiplication and division.

- Using the multiplication symbol
- Counting in 2s 5s and 10s
- Sharing and grouping

We will then move on to Shape and fractions

- 2.D and 3.D shapes and their properties
- Finding and recognising halves, thirds and quarters.
