



PARKING ON SCHOOL GROUNDS



The only place permissible for parents to stop their cars in the mornings is the 'drop off zone' where the parents can quickly stop, say good bye, allow their children to exit the car and then drive off to allow other parents to do the same. This should take no longer than a few seconds. Some parents have been

seen waiting as their child walks up the path, brushing their child's hair and conversing with other parents! It is inconsiderate and dangerous as lengthy queues form behind waiting to get in to the school and blocking Bank Road. At the end of the day parents must park their cars on the street and walk into the school unless you have a disabled parking badge or legitimate reason and have an agreement in advance from either Mr BM, Mr Smith or the office. Blue Badge Holders are



asked to <u>arrive no later 15:05 as the vehicle access gates are then closed</u>. These measures are in place for the safety and wellbeing of our children at St Peter's and to ensure fairness to all parents. Please respect this and park accordingly and safely <u>please do not park in front of the school gates or on the double yellow lines (which is illegal)</u>. Please also ensure anyone else collecting your children on your behalf are aware of this.

Walking in the School Grounds

A number of parents are also walking with their children through the car parks. This is very dangerous. Please use the footpaths provided (dotted green arrows), do not cut through the car park (red crosses) and set a good example for our children.
