YEAR 3 & 4 VISIT TO ROMAN BATHS MONDAY 5 FEBRUARY 2024

As part of our topic 'Ancient Roman Culture', we have arranged a visit to the Roman Baths in Bath on Monday 5th February 2024.

The children will take part in a workshop called "Unearthing Aquae Sulis" and have a tour of the Baths.

The timetable for the day is as follows:

- Coach leaving St Peter's at 8.45am
- Arrive at the Roman Baths at 10:00am
- Leave the Roman Baths at 1:50pm
- Return to St Peter's at approximately 3.15pm

The children will need to:

- Wear school uniform
- Bring a packed lunch (including a plastic bottle of water and snacks for both morning and afternoon) in a small back pack.

Your child will be in a small group accompanied by a member of staff or parent helper.

To enable the visit to take place a voluntary contribution of £13.20 per child is required to cover the cost of the trip. The cost of the trip (£21.33 per child) has been subsidised generously by a donation from the Henbury Lands Trust and our tour d'Pilning trip fund allowing us to subsidise the cost of the trip to you. If any parents of a pupil are in receipt of benefit related free school meals or have difficulty making the payment, please contact the school office in confidence to discuss financial support.
