

The School Nursing Service recently visited your child's school to carry out vision screening and height and weight measurements for the National Child Measurement Programme. If your child was measured on the day, we would like to thank you for their participation and confirm that you will soon receive a letter through the post with your child's measurements, please ensure that the school have your correct address. The School Nursing Service will also contact you if your child's screening suggests reduced vision.

If your child was not in school on the day of measurement you can use the [NHS BMI calculator](#) to input your child's height and weight to check their growth. You can contact your GP or the School Nursing Service if you would like to discuss your child's measurements. We would also encourage you to take your child to the community optician to have their vision checked and ensure good eye health.
