Cycle: A Terms 5 and 6

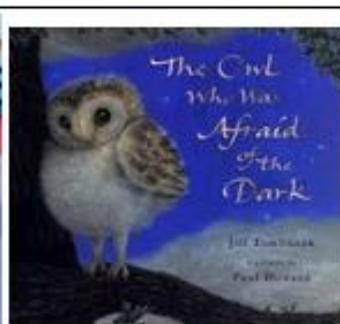
Year: 2023 – 2024

KS1

Theme: 'What would it be like to live in a different country?'

English

- We will look at a variety of text types: poetry, fiction and non-fiction that fit with our topic.
- We will write longer series of linked sentences such as narratives, descriptions, and poems.
- We will write nonfiction texts, such as non-chronological reports and fact files.
- We will continue extending our sentences using conjunctions.
- We will use different types of punctuation to make our writing flow.
- We will discuss, our books, orally rehearse parts of the text and retrieve answers.



Mathematics

Year 1: We will start by looking at multiplication and division. We will focus on:

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Making and recognising equal groups.

We will then move on to fractions, followed by place value within 100, money and time. We will focus on:

- Recognising 1/2s and 1/4s.
- Partitioning numbers into groups of 10s and 1s.
- Recognising notes and coins.
- Telling the time to the hour and to the half an hour.

Year 2: We will start by looking at length and height and position and direction. We will focus on:

- Measuring in metres and centimetres.
- Describing position and turns.

We will then move on to time. We will focus on:

- O'clock and half past.
- Quarter past and quarter to.
