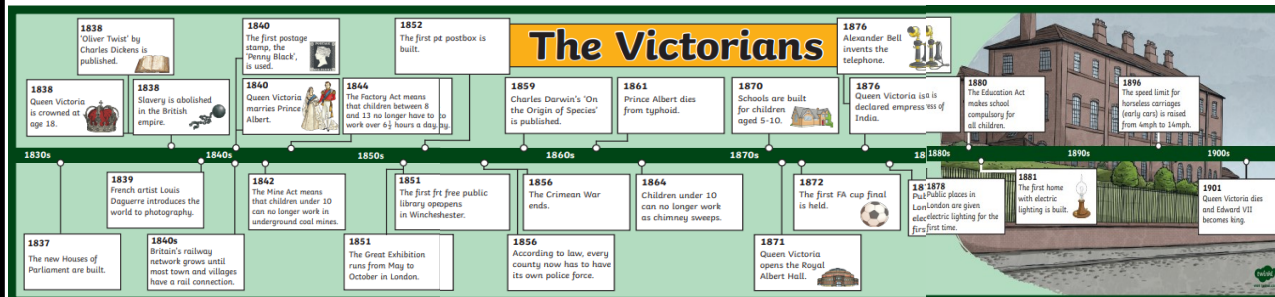

Queen Victoria	Queen of the United Kingdom from 1837 -1901.
Isambard Kingdom Brunel	Important engineer in British history.
Invention	Creating something or adapting an existing object.
Material	The substance used to make something.
Plastic	A solid material which is typically synthetic.
Metal	A solid material which is typically shiny.

Isambard Kingdom Brunel was born on 9th April 1806 in Portsmouth, England.

Brunel was an engineer.

The monarch at the time was Queen Victoria.

This was called the Victorian era, a time of great change and invention.

Brunel linked Bristol to London with a network of bridges, tunnels and track call The Great Western Railway (opened 1838) which we still use today.
