Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you to tell you about an exciting opportunity that St Peter's choir will be taking part in.

On Monday 9th of January 2023 we will be travelling to The Resorts World Arena, Birmingham to take part in the Young Voices event. Young Voices is a nationwide choir concert, one of the biggest in the world! It takes place every year with thousands of children taking part. As your child has joined choir club this year we would like to offer this incredible experience to them. We are going to be running some fundraising events (see below) to help with the cost of the event. Therefore, we are unsure of a final amount but there will be a contribution to the costs required of around £15-20 per child to attend. This includes the coach journey to and from the venue, a Young Voices Concert T-Shirt and a torch. The cost has been substantially subsidised thanks to sharing a coach with Almondsbury school & a generous donation from Friends of St Peter's, costs for entering the event have been met by the school.

We will:

- Leave school at 11:00 promptly
- Arrive in Birmingham for approximately 13:15
- Depart Birmingham at 21:30
- Arrive at St Peter's approximately 23:00

As we will be arriving very late back to school, Mr Smith has agreed that the children could arrive later to school the following morning if felt necessary for your child.

Our first fundraising event will be a cake sale on Friday 11th November, please could your child bring in a contribution to this on the Friday morning and leave it with their class teacher. The cake sale will take place immediately after school. Additionally, we are going to do a practise performance on Tuesday 29th November from 2:45-3:20pm. Parents, wider family and governors will be invited and we will be kindly asking for a donation at the end of the performance.

Below is a permission slip to attend the Young Voices event. Please complete the slip, with your child's T-shirt size and return with an initial £10 to pay for the T-shirt. I have also enclosed an order form for any parents who wish to purchase a ticket to attend the event, please note transport cannot be provided by the school, so parents will have to make their own arrangements. If any parents of a pupil are in receipt of benefit related free school meals, please contact the school office in confidence to discuss financial support.
