History: The Stone Age to the Iron Age

- **The Stone Age** is thought to have lasted roughly 3.4 million years. It is characterized into 3 periods
- - The Palaeolithic period (2.3 million years ago to 10000BC)
- - The Mesolithic period (10000BC – 4000BC)
- - The Neolithic period (4000bc – 2300BC) *Some overlap with the start of the Bronze Age*
