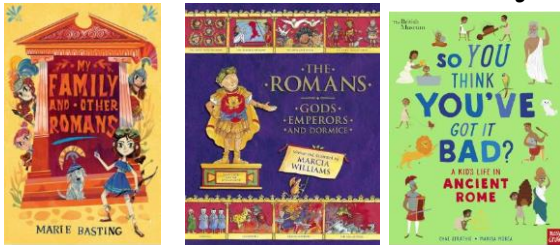

We will improve our writing through looking at punctuation, noun phrases, audience and tense.

We will discuss, our books, orally rehearse parts of the text, retrieve answers and infer about the events.
