ENGLISH

- Find out about the life of a famous scientist, e.g. Charles Darwin, and write a biography about their life.
- Create poem about the natural environment. Use figurative devices to create imagery.
- Write a story about being stranded on the Galapagos islands.

SCIENCE AND IT

- What if humans continued to evolve? Draw and label a diagram of an evolved human being.
- Use www.greatplanthunt.org to identify plants in your garden and local area.
- What is a polar bear had to live in a desert? How would it have to adapt? Draw and write about a creature with its new adaptation for a new habitat.

HUMANITIES

- Research about the interesting life of Mary Anning—the world's first female palaeontologist.
- Take a trip to the local Aust cliffs to see if you can find any fossils.
- Use Google Earth to map out where the Endurance sailed – make a list of the seas she would have travelled through.

PSHE/ COLLECTIVE WORSHIP

- Write an acrostic poem using our value 'TRUST'.
- Create a ship charter for the crew of the HMS Beagle (Darwin's ship) – what values would have been helpful for them to achieve and work together

CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

- Collect shells or fossils and sketch them closely—how could you create light and shade using blending?
- Create a model of Darwin's ship—HMS Beagle
- Create art about your favourite species using collage technique.

MATHEMATICS

- Find out how many km Darwin travelled on his expedition in total – can you convert this to miles?
- Research the monthly average temperatures in UK and Galapagos. Use subtraction to calculate differences
