## PERSONAL GOAL

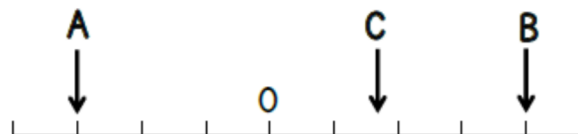

## MATHEMATICS

- Three numbers are marked on a number line.



- The difference between A and B is 28
- The difference between A and C is 19
- D is 10 less than C

3 is a factor of this number.

The sum of its digits is one third of the number.

What number is Louise thinking of?
