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Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Welcome back! I hope you have all enjoyed a well-earned break. The children have now settled into life in Class 3 and have returned to school ready to jump straight back into learning. Please note, there will be a change to the weekly teaching structure this term. For the remainder of the school year, Mr Hunt will teach the class on Thursday afternoons. Mrs Nelmes will continue to work alongside us in class throughout the week.

Topic: Our class topic for this Term is 'Robots.' This Topic will link our learning from across the curriculum. For more information on this, please see the curriculum map attached which details our learning for this term.

Homework: The Pick 'n' Mix homework has been sent out alongside the newsletter. These are optional and you can choose as many or as few as you like to complete. Children are encouraged to bring in their work to share. It was fantastic to see so many fantastic homework projects shared with the class last term and I was really impressed by the creativity!

Spellings will be issued on a Tuesday with children being tested the following week. Please ensure your child brings in their homework book on this day so they are able to stick in their new spellings. The children are also tested on their times tables daily. You can help support your child's learning by practising spellings and times tables with them regularly.

PE: Weekly Swimming lessons will resume on Friday 15th November. The class will also continue to benefit from sports coaching led by Forever Sports on a Thursday afternoon. This term, the children will be learning Badminton in these lessons. Please make sure your child has a full, labelled PE kit in class each week for these sessions. Please note, jewellery will need to be removed or covered with tap.

Reading: Please continue to read with your children at home as often as you can. It is also beneficial for the children to discuss their understanding of a text with an adult. Discussing unfamiliar vocabulary will also help support your child with writing at school.
