Year 4 Newsletter-Term 2

Challenging Ourselves	<p>A reminder that 'Timestable Rockstars' is still running for our class, using the same passwords as Year 3. If you need another copy of this information, please let me know.</p> <p>Also- Nessie is running for the same children as Year 3, again using the same passwords.</p> <p>The children will have opportunities during the week to access our school iPads to practise their knowledge on these programmes but it is important for them to also be practising at home where possible.</p>
Maths	<p>This term we will be focusing on multiplication and division. Looking at the 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12 times tables as well as their division facts. We will also look to multiply and divide by 2 and 3 digit numbers.</p>
English and Topic	<p>For this term (and most probably the next), we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. Where they fit into a historical timeline, what we have discovered from their tombs and are there curses involved?</p>
RE and SMSC	<p>There will be a weekly Religious Education lesson, our big theme this term is 'Salvation'. There will also be a SMSC (Spiritual, Moral, Social, Cultural) lesson. This may take the form of circle time, a question and answer session or maybe a quiet time. It will be flexible and could incorporate any issues arising in class at the time.</p>
PE	<p>Our PE lessons will be on a</p> <p>Lesson 1: Tuesday-Team games</p> <p>Lesson 2: Thursday-Badminton (Forever Sport)</p> <p>Children will need suitable clothing for indoor and outdoor PE and this should be kept in school through the term. If possible, we would recommend wearing trainers for PE instead of daps, as they provide better support, especially for games activities. All jewellery needs to be removed for PE sessions (including ear-rings). Newly pierced ears can be taped up with tape provided from home.</p>
Reading	<p>The children have opportunities to read during the day and therefore it is important that they choose a suitable book that is challenging and engaging. If a library book becomes lost, please write me a short note so that I can take it off the computer system.</p>

Spellings will be taught during the week and five sent home on a Friday. These will be tested the following Friday. Where possible, all children will work on the same spellings.
