- Express their own understanding of what Jesus would do in relation to a moral dilemma from the world today.



**Music:**

Children will learn to listen and appraise 'Make You Feel My Love' and other pop ballads.

**French:**

On the move

Children will develop their conversational skills via transport, direction and movement. Children will learn how to respond to simple instructions for direction and movement and find places on a map.

**Enquiry:**

- The children will study Earth and Space in science, they will be able to:
  - Describe the sun, earth and moon and name the planets in the solar system independently
  - Explain night and day and support the idea that different places on earth experience night and day at different times.
