Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Welcome back to Reception. We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to 2020! This is a very busy term with lots of learning and adventures so please read the dates and information carefully.

Topic: Our topic this term is all about 'Superheroes!'. We will be finding out about all different types of superheroes including superheroes that help us in everyday life such as nurses, doctors, the police, the fire services and many more!

Transition: Please take into account that children can often be unsettled returning to school after spending time at home and to minimise this please encourage children to walk into the classroom and put their belongings away independently which is a routine they are familiar with.

Toast: A reminder that we will only accept 5ps, 10ps, 20ps or 50ps for toast in the mornings. So please only bring change. Children pay daily from Monday to Friday. Your child is responsible for paying for their toast daily and are reminded each day during registration. Please remind your child if their toast money is in their bag or book bag.

Staying active: This term P.E. will take place inside on a Wednesday afternoon and a Friday afternoon (outside-weather dependent). Outdoor Learning will also take place on a Friday afternoon.



Please ensure full P.E. kits (including outdoor sports shoes e.g. trainers) are in school at all times. All items must be labelled and in a labelled bag when they come into school. If they are not labelled we will send them home until labelled.
