SATs week: Please note this takes place on the week beginning **11th May 2020**.

Year 6 camp: Please note that the full camp payment is due by **Wednesday 29th March**. There will be a short meeting with more information about Year 6 camp on **Monday 23rd March at 3.30pm in the school hall** – more information will follow.
