### ENQUIRY: How has crime and punishment changed over time?

#### SCIENCE AND IT

- Make a paper helicopter and investigate the effects of air resistance and gravity. Time how long your helicopter takes to fall to the ground. Can you make a new paper helicopter that falls more slowly?

#### PSHE/ COLLECTIVE WORSHIP

- Research Tudor family symbols/crests and design a crest that represents your family.
- Consider how you show forgiveness every day and what it means to you.

#### ENGLISH

- Write a recount from someone in Shakespeare's day. It could be an actor or somebody visiting a play at the Globe.
- Have a go at writing your own play in the style of William Shakespeare.
- Write a diary entry from a day in the life of a Victorian prisoner .

#### CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

- Research, design and make a traditional Tudor house.
- Draw a Tudor style self portrait.

#### MATHEMATICS

- Practice calculating using all 4 operations
  - Addition and subtraction up to 7 digits
  - Multiply and divide numbers up to 4 digits by 1 digit
- Can you find examples of where there are fractions in every day life?

#### TOPIC

- Imagine you are living in Victorian times and you want public executions, such as hanging, to stop. Write a persuasive letter to Queen Victoria explaining why she should pass a law to stop hanging. Use modal verbs and adverbs of possibility.
