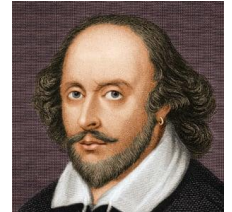

RE: Salvation- What did Jesus do to save human beings?

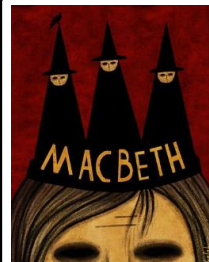
- Explain what Christians mean when they say that Jesus' death was a sacrifice

How has crime and punishment changed throughout time?

Music:

Children will learn to listen and appraise 'Fresh Prince of Bel Air' and other Hip Hop songs.
