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Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Welcome back to Term 4! How quickly is the time going? We have another very busy term planned, with lots of learning and adventures so please read the dates and information carefully.

Topic: Our topic this term is '5,4,3,2,1 Blast off!' which is all about our wonderful world and space. Please see an attached overview of the planned activities, although this will continue to evolve alongside the children's learning and interests.

Toast: A reminder that we will only accept **5ps, 10ps, 20ps or 50ps** for toast in the mornings. So please only bring these coins as we are unable to change up larger coins. Children pay daily and your child is responsible for paying for their toast as they are reminded during registration.

Staying active: This term P.E. will take place on a **Monday afternoon (inside) and a Thursday afternoon (outside)**. Please ensure full P.E. kits (including outdoor sports shoes e.g. trainers) and outdoor learning kits are in school as soon as possible. Please check that all items are labelled and in a labelled bag when they come into school at the start of term.



Proud Cloud vouchers: We will be sending home three Proud Cloud vouchers to be completed by an adult and returned to school throughout this term – keep an eye out for these in bookbags.

Stay and Play: On Friday 27th March 2020 you are invited into the classroom for "Stay and Play" from 2.50pm-3.20pm. to engage in some play opportunities based around this term's topic. Please inform a member of staff if you are unable to attend so we can ensure your child has a buddy who can come and support them.

Home tasks: Please continue to read daily with your child. We ask that you read **at least** three times per week. We will be monitoring how many times your child has read at home per week so please ensure that this is embedded into your home routines. Any advice on developing the skill of blending or supporting reading at home please speak with Miss Cox or Miss Daly after school.

Home toys: Children should be well settled into school life now. As part of our school rules we cannot permit to have home toys and teddies bought into school. Please reiterate this at home.

School Library slot: The children are now set up on our library system. We intend to set aside time each Friday for the children to go to the school library and choose a book to take home to read for pleasure. These books will be changed each Friday so the book which is chosen will be kept for the duration of the week. Please use these books alongside the decodable phonics books in order to find a balance between reading according to your child's phonics development and exploring the language in story books.
