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Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Welcome back. I hope you have all enjoyed the half term break. Our termly newsletter will keep you updated on what we will be getting up to during each term. This term, Class 4 will be taught by Mr Buckley on a Wednesday AM/ Miss Sambrook PM and Mr Hunt the rest of the week. Mrs Cole will be working alongside us in class throughout the week.
