Dear Parent/Carer,

As we come to the end of the first full week of the academic year, I wanted to again extend my thanks on behalf of the team here at St Peter's for your support in getting the children in and out of school safely so far this term; your continued cooperation and understanding meant that our pupils have been able to get to class safely and continue their learning with their friends.

Alongside this message is a letter from the local authority reminding you of some of the key messages we must all bear in mind at this time. However, I have also listed below some reminders of our own that I would be extremely grateful if you could take a look at and, where possible, respond positively:

- **In the morning, please do not arrive at the main gates until your eldest child's given start time**
- **If possible, walk or cycle to and from school; Bank Road is extremely busy as always and we must do all we can to keep it accessible to all**
- **Do not come through the gates to line-up with your child/children until you have been called forward by a member of staff (most days this will be Miss Welsh)**
- **In the afternoon, please do not arrive at the main gates until your youngest child's given finish time**
- **Do not come through the gates to collect your child/children until you have been called forward by a member of staff (most days this will be Mr Buckley)**
- **After drop-off and collection, please do not remain on-site or gather on Bank Road to talk; we realise it's important to catch-up with friends, however our new systems depend on parents/carers spending as little time out of their cars as possible.**
- **Please ensure your child comes to school with a water bottle that has their name on it**
- **On days that your child has PE, please ensure they come to school wearing their PE kit**
