Using this as inspiration, alongside model texts, the children will produce a narrative and a persuasive leaflet.

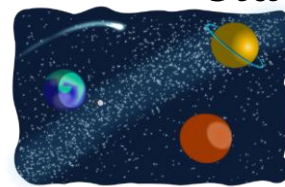
RE:

What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?

- Children will make connections between Muslim practice of the Five Pillars and their beliefs about God and the Prophet Muhammad.
- They will describe and reflect on the significance of the holy Qur'an to Muslims
- Describe the forms of guidance a Muslim uses and compare them to their own
- They will make connections between the Mosque and beliefs of Muslims.
