

## Holiday activities and food clubs: Summer 2021

We are offering holiday activities and food clubs for children aged 5 to 16 years who live in South Gloucestershire. This is funded by the Department for Education (DfE).

The activities and food clubs will run in the summer holidays (on weekdays only) between 22 July and 3 September.

**Places are free for children who get benefits-related free school meals (not universal infant free school meals). Children attending that get benefits-related free school meals will be given a free lunch.**

Depending on the activity, you may also be able to pay for your child to attend if they do not get free school meals.

### **Activity and club safety**

The providers have experience of running holiday activities for children and young people and have the appropriate indemnity insurance for their activities.
